Ageism


Prejudice or discrimination on the grounds of a person's age.





State Sex Education Policies and Requirements at a Glance

- Massachusetts schools are not required to teach sex education.
- Curriculum must explain the benefits of abstinence.
- If sex education is offered, curriculum is not required to include instruction on sexual orientation or gender identity.





Costs \$11,000 for a vaginal birth and \$20,000 for a cesarean section, not including prenatal or postnatal care.




Teenagers can only work 40 hours a week with a minimum wage of \$15 per hour.

At age 33 she is giving Ted Talks about her experience working with Boston politicians.




