#### FORM GSBS17: COMPLETION OF DEGREE – STIPEND TERMINATION DATE

### **Policies**

Student stipends are guaranteed for three weeks from the date of the defense exam but may be terminated earlier by the student. The stipend can be extended up to six weeks from the date of the defense exam with the agreement of the student's mentor.

A student has 120 days after the defense exam to complete all degree requirements. Failure to complete all degree requirements will result in withdrawal from the GSBS and no degree will be awarded. Extensions will be considered only with documentation of extreme extenuating circumstances.

The date on which all requirements for graduation have been completed is considered the date the student has completed their program.

UMass Chan Medical School confers degrees four times each year (the Sunday after Memorial Day (Commencement), August 31, December 31, and March 31. A student's degree will be conferred on the first date following completion of all requirements.
