

UMass Memorial – Marlborough Hospital Women's Imaging Center is being relocated from 28 Newton Street Southborough to the hospital campus at 157 Union Street, Marlborough in the fall of 2020.

The Women's Imaging Center at Marlborough Hospital will be a 4,000 square foot, free standing, single story building on the property. The Center will be handicapped accessible, have an area for vehicles to drive up to the front entrance to drop off patients and there will be 16 dedicated parking spaces for patients. The area surrounding the Center will be landscaped and there will be sidewalks installed for patients to access the main hospital building.

The Marlborough Hospital Women's Imaging Center which is currently located in Southborough, is accredited by the American College of Radiology and holds a valid mammography license and certificate of inspection from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. The Women's Imaging Center has been designated as a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence by the Commission on Quality and Safety and the Commission on Breast Imaging of the American College of Radiology.

Services offered at the Women's Breast Imaging Center include the following:

- 3D mammography (tomosynthesis)
- Automated Breast Ultrasound System (ABUS)
- Breast ultrasound
- Bone density testing
- Stereotactic breast biopsy
- Ultrasound guided breast biopsy

Board-certified and fellowship trained UMass Memorial Medical Group dedicated breast radiologists will provide patient consultation and immediate diagnostic mammography and breast ultrasound results.
